Learned counsel states that the petitioner had earlier moved this Court by filing CRM-M-2716-2018 with the same prayer, in which vide order 16.02.2018 the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and thereafter move an application for regular bail and then the trial Court was to decide the same expeditiously keeping in view the fact that other co-accused had already been acquitted for lack of evidence.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court in pursuance of the direction aforesaid as he had to leave abroad on account of some urgency. Thereafter, the petition was got dismissed as withdrawn.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner on identical grounds and for the same relief.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 08.02.2019. On his doing so and on filing an application for regular bail, the Trial Court shall decide the same keeping in view the fact that other accused have already been acquitted.
