Counsel seeks directions in the same terms as per order dated 28.11.2018 passed by this Court in **CWP-25059-2018** titled as **Shri Ram Krishan Paramhans Shiksha Parishad Vs. State of Haryana & others**. It may be noticed that the petitioner therein had been issued a Letter of Intent dated 01.08.2018 by the National Council for Teachers Education and it is under such circumstance that the directions had been issued to the Director, State Council of Educational Research and Training, Gurugram, Haryana to examine the issue pertaining to approval of the faculty of the petitioner/Institute.

In the present case concededly, the petitioner has not been issued any Letter of Intent by the National Council for Teachers Education. Counsel submits that the matter is still under consideration and an inspection has been carried out.

Under such circumstances, no interference in the matter is called for. Writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner/Institute

to approach the Court afresh for issuance of appropriate directions after issuance of Letter of Intent.
