The present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner-husband against the order dated 10.10.2018, vide which the conditional warrants of arrest were issued against him for effecting the recovery of Rs.50.00 Lakh.

On 11.01.2019, while issuing notice of motion in this case, the order issuing warrants of arrest were stayed till today on request of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is not able to arrange money as warrants of arrest had been issued against him and he is on the run. With the condition that he shall deposit the balance amount of Rs.50.00 Lakh with the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner-husband states that the petitioner is not ready and willing to comply with the said order.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is dismissed with a direction to the Executing Court to proceed further with the matter.
