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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J (Oral)**

Instant writ petition was filed assailing a notice dated 6.12.2018 (Annexure P-1A) issued by the DHBVNL calling upon the petitioner to deposit an amount of Rs.64,59,776/- as the outstanding amount against electricity connection no. CP31-005.

During the course of hearing of the instant petition, the following order was passed on 25.3.2019:-

*“In pursuance to the order dated 13.02.2019 passed by this Court Sh.Raj Kumar, Superintending Engineer, Operation Circle, Bhiwani, Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited has come present in Court.*

*A number of queries were put to the officer. Mr. Raj Kumar makes a statement that he has just joined on the assignment and he would examine the entire issue in its entirety and an order afresh would be issued supported by a detailed calculation-sheet within a period of four weeks from today. Statement is accepted.*

*It would be appreciated if the petitioner/consumer is associated in such decision making process.*

*Hearing in the instant petition is accordingly*

*deferred to 14.05.2019.*

*Court has been apprised that in pursuance to the interim directions dated 13.02.2019, the petitioner has made a tentative deposit of Rs. 15 lakhs and as a consequence thereto the electricity connection has been restored.”*

It is not in dispute that in compliance of order dated 25.3.2019 an order dated 18.4.2019 has been passed and as per which the outstanding amount stands determined as Rs.33,19,603/-.

Counsel for the petitioner concedes that copy of the order dated 18.4.2019 has been supplied to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to raise a challenge to the order dated 18.4.2019, if, so advised and on all such grounds that may be available in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
