The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.40 dated 19.04.2017 registered under Section 379-B, 34 IPC at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that in this very case, the petitioner was released on bail pending trial. He had been appearing before the trial Court. However, on 30.11.2018, he could not appear before the trial Court because he forgot about the date being under distress due to the illness of the parents. As a result, the bail granted to the petitioner has been cancelled and warrants of arrest have been issued. Therefore, he apprehends his arrest. It is further contended by the counsel for the petitioner that he has no intention to flee from course of justice. He intends to appear before the trial Court and to face the proceedings in accordance with law. The only prayer is that the petitioner be protected against his arrest.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. S.S. Cheema, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He has no objection if the petitioner appears before the trial Court to face the further proceedings.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 05.02.2019. It is further directed that in case the petitioner so appears before the trial Court on or before 05.02.2019, the petitioner shall be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
