The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.227 dated 21.12.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Heard.

The allegations levelled against the petitioners are of general nature. No specific entrustment was made to them.

Learned State counsel state that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the orders dated 8.2.2019 and 13.2.2019 are made

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
