Petitioner, who is participating in the selection process for Group-D post under General category, is seeking direction that he should be awarded marks under the Socio-Economic criteria.

Pursuant to the order dated 30.01.2019 passed by this Court, result of the petitioner has been brought in Court, a perusal of which shows that he (petitioner) has been awarded 63 marks in the written examination and 05 marks under Socio-Economic criteria, total 68 marks. Last candidate selected under the General category, has secured 69 marks. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the candidates, who have got 68 marks, have been kept in the waiting list.

In view of the said fact, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to keep the name of petitioner in the waiting list, as he has got 68 marks.
