Notice of motion was issued on 28.05.2018 for 24.08.2018.

Petitioner was directed to file correct address of the respondent within a week. The said order was not complied with. On 27.02.2019, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner, still the case was adjourned by directing learned counsel for the petitioner to do the needful by the adjourned date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner was directed even to serve the respondent through his counsel appearing in the trial

Court. Liberty was also granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent by means of *dasti* process.

As per office report, *dasti* process has not been received so far. Since morning none has appeared despite three pass overs.

Dismissed for non prosecution.
