Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondents No. 3 to 5.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 19.11.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
