This application has been filed on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 for pre-poning the date of hearing of the main case from 20.02.2019 to an early date.

Mr.Ankush Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioners, present in court, accepts notice.

In view of the averments made in the application, present application is allowed. With the consent of the parties, the case is taken up for hearing today itself.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents Nos.2 and 3 to provide protection to the lives and

liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

This case came up for hearing on 28.1.2019 when both the petitioners and respondents No.4 to 6 were present in court. Respondents No.4 to 6 had stated that they will perform the marriage of Neha Rani – petitioner No.1 with Avnish – petitioner No.2 as per their customs within 20 days. It was agreed that Neha Rani will accompany respondents No.4 to 6 to her parental home. Respondents No.4 to 6 also undertook that they will not harass or physically harm petitioner No.1.

Today, by filing a miscellaneous application, respondents No.4 to 6 have stated that both the petitioners belong to the same *Gotra* and the same village and it would not be possible for respondents No.4 to 6 to solemnise their marriage. They, however, state that as the marriage of the petitioners has already been solemnized on 25.1.2019, they have no objection to petitioner No.1 residing with petitioner No.2.

Both the parties are agreeable to the above settlement.

Petitioner No.1 shall accompany petitioner No.2 from the court itself. Respondents No.4 to 6 shall remain bound by their statement and shall not cause any harm or harass the petitioners in any manner.

In view of the above development, no further orders are called for.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
