Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the decision rendered by this Court in CWP No.1486 of 2018 and other connected writ petitions decided on 13.12.2018 to claim that the petitioner is also similarly situated as the petitioners in those writ petitions and hence is entitled for the same benefit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 27.12.2018 (Annexure P-10) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 27.12.2018 (Annexure P-10) by passing a speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 27.12.2018 (Annexure P-10), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 27.12.2018 (Annexure P-10) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
