The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.371 dated 30.4.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 342, 380, 457 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") (later on challan was presented under Section 395 IPC) at Police Station 10, District Gurgaon, Haryana.

Heard.

The FIR was registered on 30.04.2017 at about 1.45 p.m. against unknown thieves for committing theft in the house of the complainant. Theft of ` 5 lacs in cash, one kilogram silver jewellery and 86 tola of gold jewellery was committed. The petitioner has been arrested.

Two gold karahs, two gold ear rings, one gold necklace and one gold

Mangalsutra was recovered from him.

Co-accused namely Ram Dass, Dharam Pal, Ram Singh and Satish Pardi have already been granted bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Jang Bahadur @ Jangu is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

(a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

(b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.

(c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
