This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 10.05.2018 registered under Section 420 IPC (already granted pre-arrest bail under this section) and Sections 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC (added later on) at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition and states that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail before the court below and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It

is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before

05.03.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 08.03.2019.

Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
