Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner – Arsh Arora, in case FIR No. 345, dated 27.08.2017, registered under Sections 145, 150, 151, 152, 153, 146, 121, 216, 120-B, 121-A IPC, at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.
