Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.22 dated 23.03.2018 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom as well as for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to issue police clearance certificate to the petitioner till final decision of the present petition.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, has submitted that the cancellation report has been prepared on 11.03.2019

and the same will be presented before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the petitioner has applied for extension of her visa in New Zealand, which is going to expire in March, 2019 itself, the petitioner apprehends that in case the police verification is sought by the Embassy of New Zealand, the police may not issue the police clearance certificate to the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the police has prepared the cancellation report, though the complainant would have a right to file the protest petition or complaint before the trial Court, however, on the face of it, I find that there should be no restriction in issuance of police clearance certificate to the petitioner, if any such verification is required.

Accordingly, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala as well as SHO, Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala are directed to issue necessary certificate, as applied by the petitioner.

Disposed of, accordingly.
