This petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail/extension of interim bail granted vide order dated 07.01.2019 to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 17.05.2018, registered at Police Station Sujanpur, District Pathankot, under Sections 302, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been granted interim bail for three weeks by this Court on 07.01.2019 due to her ill health and to look after her newly born child. He states that the petitioner is still suffering from ill health and requests that her interim bail may be extended.

As per Annexure P-3-medical certificate, which is on record, issued by M.L. Civil Hospital Yamunanagar, the petitioner is suffering from fever and bleeding problem.

Under these circumstances, the interim bail already granted to the petitioner is extended for 10 days more and she is directed to now surrender herself on 08.02.2019 at 10:00 A.M. sharp before concerned jail authorities. However, it is made clear that no further extension shall be granted.

Disposed of accordingly.
