Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate security/police protection and further directing respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the copy of statement recorded jointly on behalf of respondents No.4, 5 and 7, who are father and uncles of petitioner No.1 to the effect that they have they have no objection to the marriage entered into between the petitioners and they will not interfere in their life.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
