The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Baljit Singh has apprised the Court that the petitioners have jointly filed an affidavit, wherein they have expressed no threat to their married life. Statements of respondents No.4 to 8 have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. The copies of the

joint affidavit as well as statements of private respondents have been produced.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition, as the alleged threat has vanished.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
