This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 7.4.2018, registered under Sections 148/149/341/323/379-B/325/506 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that other co-accused Bhim Singh has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 15.12.2018 passed in CRM-M-43359-2018 and the Trial Court has wrongly held that the role of co-accused-Bhim Singh was different from the role of present petitioner.

Learned Assistant Advocate General on instructions from ASI Krishan has accepted that role of co-accused Bhim Singh was similar to the present petitioner.

Custody certificate dated 6.2.2019 by way of affidavit of

Shamsher Singh Dahiya-Sp, Superintendent of Prison, Central Jail No-1 (Hissar) Haryana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 7 months and 25 days.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
