MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner-Deepk Kumar has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.278 dated 27.06.2018 under Section 302 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 12.09.2018.

The FIR was registered on the statement of complainant, namely, Reeta Rani wherein it is alleged that her son, namely, Pushpinder Kumar @ Mani was married and had a daughter. Mani had an illicit relations with Seema wife of Rajesh Kumar resident of Gagandeep colony village Bhattian as a result of the same, Rajesh had enmity with the son of the complainant. On 19.06.2018, when son of the complainant did not return home she inquired about him and suspected that Rajesh Kumar had killed Mani on 19.06.2018 along with his nephew, namely, Deepak and threw his

body opposite empty plot at the corner of the road. On these broad allegations FIR was registered.

At the outset, learned counsel for the State has apprised the Court that the trial is at the advanced stage and seven prosecution witnesses already have been examined out of total 12 witnesses.

The petitioner was arrested in the case on 12.09.2018 and apparently trial is progressing fast. Resultantly, considering the nature of offence and the fact that the trial is at the advanced stage, no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
