The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari, submits that petitioner in consequence of order dated 30.01.2019 has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and does not oppose the grant of bail.

The learned counsel for the complainant has stoutly opposed the grant of bail.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 30.01.2019 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
