Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.5 dated 04.01.2014 under Sections 419, 420, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 31.01.2019:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that initially, the FIR was registered against six persons and the challan was presented only against one person Mam Chand, Numberdar. It is further submitted that the petitioner as well as his wife Sudesh Rani, who is purchaser of the property, were cited as prosecution witnesses, as per the list of witnesses attached with the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel further submits that later on, when

the statement of Sudesh Rani was recorded, the prosecution moved an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning some additional persons other than the petitioner, however, later on, the said application was dismissed as withdrawn on 11.07.2018. It is also submitted that the police want to arrest the petitioner without there being any cogent evidence against him.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurmukh Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
