The petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 21.01.2019 (Annexure P-1) whereby his bail has been cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 21.01.2019, the petitioner was admitted in a Drug De-addiction Centre as is apparent from certificate dated 25.11.2018 (Annexure P-2). Due to miscommunication, an application for exemption could not be filed. In case protection is granted, the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court within a week.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let two copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 08.02.2019 and to move an application for grant of regular bail. In case such an application is filed, the trial Court is directed to allow the same, subject to its satisfaction.
