The Sirsa City Bus Service, Sirsa has filed the instant petition assailing the award dated 18.03.2016 passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Sirsa (Annexure P-3) only to the extent whereby directions had been issued to adjust the Drivers and Conductors of four buses in other departments as per policy/guidelines of the Government.

During the course of hearing of the petition, it has gone uncontroverted that in the petition that had been filed under Section 22-C of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 for settlement of disputes with regard to plying of several buses by the Sirsa City Bus Service Society, statement of the City Magistrate, Sirsa had been got recorded and which was to the following effect:

“We will try to adjust the Drivers and Conductors of these four buses in other Departments as per the policy/guidelines of the Government.”

Clearly, the impugned directions contained in the award dated 18.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) is in terms of the statement recorded by the City Magistrate, Sirsa and as afore reproduced.

No infirmity in the assailed directions as such is found.

At this stage, counsel prays for withdrawal of the writ petition.

Disposed of as withdrawn.
