Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing of this petition, accused have been arrested and the investigations are in progress. Hence, he submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition, at this stage. However, he submits that the petitioner is receiving threats from the accused.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar, has submitted that on the basis of the aforesaid threat, a fresh FIR No.29 dated 09.02.2019 has been registered.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, Commissioner of Police, Gurugram is directed to examine threat to the petitioner and decide remedial action, if required. For this purpose, Commissioner of Police would decide after hearing the petitioner within a period of 15 days.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
