The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 432 dated 28.12.2018 under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that while obtaining job in the police as a Constable, he submitted 10th Class certificate from Open University wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 20.05.1994 while on a complaint made by one Rajesh Kumar received by the department, it was found that the petitioner had also passed his 10th Class from Haryana School Education Board wherein his date of birth was recorded as 04.11.1986. He, however, contends that both the certificates on verification have been found to be genuine. He also contends that the case against the petitioner is documentary and no recovery is to be effected. He further contends that

vide order dated 30.01.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhbir Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner has joined investigation, interim order dated 30.01.2019 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
