By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has made multiple prayers, but learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner confines her prayer for expeditious investigation. He states that the FIR No.32 under Sections 6, 8 and 18 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 354-C and 506 IPC was registered against the accused at Women Police Station, District Yamuna Nagar on 19.07.2018, but till date, investigation in the case is not complete.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Ms. Priyanka Sadar, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
