By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to official respondents so as not to harass and pressurize the petitioners to compromise the matter pertaining to DDR No.029 dated 2.1.2019, which is stated to be a cross-version to the version stated in FIR No.002 dated 2.1.2019 registered at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala under Sections 452, 323, 324, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-4) expeditiously, in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary action be taken thereupon as warranted under law, and also to ensure that the matter is investigated fairly and expeditiously and that no kind of undue pressure is put on either of the parties.

A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
