This civil revision petition has been filed seeking to challenge order dated 08.08.2017 whereby the Rent Controller gave permission to the tenant namely Karnail Singh Bhullar to contest the eviction petition filed under Section 13-B of the Urban Punjab Restriction Act, 1949.

Aggrieved against the said order the landlord approached this Court by way of instant revision petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent herein submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous on account of the fact that in the integrum, the Rent Controller has already decided the matter as ordered vide eviction order dated 20.12.2018 and places on record a copy of the same.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have also
