The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Criminal Procedure Code for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sukhwinder Kaur, in case FIR No.175 dated 26.08.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Section 498-A/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 304-B IPC added later on, at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Paramjit Kaur committed suicide by burning herself. However, before her death her dying declaration was recorded by the learned Magistrate wherein she has stated that her mother-in-law had demanded earrings on the day of Diwali.

Petitioner is a old aged lady and is in custody since 10.09.2017. Material witnesses have already been examined.

Keeping in view the totality of the circumstances and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this court is of the view that the petitioner is entitled for grant of regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail

on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
