The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Omkar Singh, Police Station City Kapurthala, submits that petitioner in consequence of order dated 31.01.2019 has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and does not oppose the grant of bail.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the same on the grounds that the petitioner had acted in a fraudulent manner and has even tricked the present complainant by not paying the settlement amount

as per compromise (Annexure P-4).

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.01.2019 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
