The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to call the status report in case FIR No.21 dated 26.01.2018, registered under Sections 387, 306, 506 IPC (Section 306 IPC added lateron) and Section 25 of the Arms Act and also to direct the official respondents to arrest respondent No.6-Ashok Kumar Pandey for the offence under Section 306 IPC and to expedite the submission of the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

It has been argued that the police failed to arrest respondent No.6-Ashok Kumar Pandey, who is roaming freely with a pistol and this is why the petitioner is unable to cultivate the land and to pay obeisance at the Samadh.

Heard. The instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, to look into the representation dated 11.01.2019 (Annexure P-8) and submit the status

report to the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate within a period of 60 days, who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. And others; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.*
