Petitioner Mahesh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.473 dated 04.11.2016, registered at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad, under Sections 323, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR is only under Sections 323, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petitioner absented himself from the Court proceedings only on one date i.e. 19.12.2018 and on that day also, an exemption application which was filed

by the present petitioner was dismissed by the trial Court. He surrendered before the trial Court on 21.01.2019 since then he is custody.

The petitioner is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
