For the reasons stated in the application, delay of 214 days in
filing the present appeal is hereby condoned. CRM stands disposed of.

Main case

State is in appeal against judgment of conviction. Respondents
have been convicted and sentenced as under:-

“I hereby sentence the convicts Ibra and Samas as
per following schedule:-

Sr.No.	Under Section(s)	Sentences imposed
1.	148 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months
2.	323/149 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months
3.	307/149 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.3000/- each to accused Ibra and Sammas and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment of six months each.

4.	341 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for one month
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Convicts namely Jahir, Liyakat and Shaukat are

sentenced as per following schedule:-

Sr. No.	Under Section (s)	Sentences imposed
1.	148 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months
2.	323/149 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months
3.	307/149 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for four years and to pay a fine of Rs.3000/- each to accused Jahir, Liyakat and Shaukat and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment of six months each.
4.	341 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for one month

Prayer is to enhance the sentence.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the appellant and with his able assistance has gone through the judgment passed as also the order of sentence.

Learned Trial Court after appreciating the evidence had considered it appropriate to award the sentence extracted above. The sentence awarded is neither shown to be un-reasonable nor suffers from any perversity. Hence, dismissed.
