The petitioners are employees of the Panipat Central Cooperative Bank Limited-respondent No. 5. The petitioners were initially appointed as Clerks and they were promoted on the post of Junior Accountant on 08.09.2017. Some senior Clerks who were not promoted during the currency of their punishment, approached respondent No. 1 by filing Appeal No. 66 of 2017 for setting aside the resolution dated 04.09.2017 whereby petitioners were promoted. The Registrar stayed the promotion order on 04.10.2017 (Annexure P-7). The petitioners filed an application for vacation of stay before the Registrar which was dismissed on 30.11.2017 (Annexure P-10).

The grievance of the petitioners now is that the appeal of the private respondents is fixed before the Registrar on 11.04.2019 and there are 21 posts of Junior Accountant lying vacant in the respondent No. 5 and as per the Service Rules, these posts are to be filled up.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to respondent No. 1 to conclude the proceedings in the Appeal No. 66 of 2017 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
