Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.610 dated 17.12.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh Sadar, District Faridabad.

On 04.02.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“.....Learned senior counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this petition qua petitioners No.1, 2, 3 & 6 namely Virender, Karan, Arjun and Jitu @ Jitender.*

*Ordered accordingly.*

*Learned senior counsel for petitioners No.4 & 5 has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, petitioners No.4 & 5 are not attributed any injury. It is further submitted that petitioner No.5 is aged about 56 years and he is a deaf and dumb*

*person. It is also submitted that the dispute is between the main accused – Sagar, who has attributed 3 injuries to the injured/complainant.*

*Learned senior counsel for petitioners No.4 & 5 has also argued that the incident occurred on 16.12.2018 whereas after obtaining the medical opinion from the private hospital on 19.12.2018, the police has invoked Section 307 IPC.....”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gajender Singh, has submitted that petitioners No.4 & 5 have joined the investigation and they are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioners No.4 & 5 vide order dated 04.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
