AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 12.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 25493 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the short ground involved in the writ petition, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to the respondents to look into representation-cum-legal notice dated 14.2.2018 (Annexure P3), made by the petitioner and decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Separate replies have been filed by the respondents. With the replies, orders have been annexed, whereby legal notice of the petitioner has been decided.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the replies filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, liberty is sought to avail remedies available in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
