Application for placing on record the reference petition, filed before the Arbitrator, Kaithal as Annexure P-6 and for exempting the petitioners from filing certified copy of the same, is allowed, in view of the averments made in the application, duly supported by affidavit. Said document is taken on record, subject to just exceptions. Office to append the same at appropriate place.

**CWP-4419-2019**

Counsel submits that he does not wish to press the present petition for payment of solatium which the petitioner is entitled for, as per memo dated 21.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) along with other instructions. It is, accordingly, submitted that the petition for reference of the dispute against the award dated 28.01.2015 (Annexure P-1), is pending before the Arbitrator-cum-Addl.Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal (Annexure P-6), in which the said claim of payment of solatium has already been raised along with the issue of payment of interest. He, however, submits that the matter has been pending consideration before the Arbitrator for a considerable time

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and therefore, he wishes to withdraw the present writ petition, with liberty to file a fresh one, for seeking appropriate directions, for early disposal.

A perusal of the memo of parties would also go on to show that the Arbitrator has not been arrayed as respondent and therefore, no such directions can be issued. Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the limited relief, as noticed above, to file a fresh one, on the same cause of action.
