Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of the petitioner for the grant of the relief which has been prayed in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the decision of this Court in **CWP No.28399 of 2013 titled as Karamjit Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 17.09.2018** (Annexure P-9).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has filed a representation with the respondents on 25.10.2018 (Annexure P-10) for the grant of the same relief as allowed to the similarly situated persons. Counsel for the petitioner further states that the said representation is still under consideration and has not been decided so far and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order in view of the law laid down by this Court mentioned above.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 25.10.2018

(Annexure P-10) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
