At the very outset, counsel for the petitioners states that in the array of parties and in document Annexure P-5 the respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala has inadvertently been mentioned as Superintendent of Police, Patiala. I find this to be indeed so. Consequently, the registry is directed to make necessary corrections.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 06.12.1993 whereas petitioner

No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 15.11.1998. They have also moved a representation before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
