The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 to 4 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 10, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Lakhwinder Singh has apprised the Court that the statements of respondents No.5, 6, 9 and 10 have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. The report of SI Lakhwinder Singh dated 23.2.2019 alongwith copies of the statements of respondents

No.5, 6, 9 and 10 have been produced. He further submits that the statements of petitioners have also been recorded, wherein they have expressed no threat to their married life. The copies of the statements have been produced alongwith the report.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the alleged threat has vanished. The petition is rendered infructuous.
