This revision has been filed for setting aside the judgments and orders dated 28.9.2017 and 29.9.2017 passed by the Trial Court and judgment and order dated 21.1.2019 passed by the Appellate Court vide which the petitioner was sentenced to undergo for simple imprisonment for a period of three months and compensation to the tune of Rs. 6,00,000/-.

Mr. Gaurav Gupta, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent-complainant. Counsel for the petitioner has handed over a draft of Rs. 3 lakhs bearing No. 119004, drawn by Union Bank, dated 25.2.2019 to the counsel for the complainant for onwards transmission to the complainant. It has been further agreed that in full and final settlement of the claim of the complainant petitioner shall pay another amount of Rs. 4 lakhs on or before 10.5.2019.

Let the petitioner and the complainant appear on that date before the Court which has granted interim bail to the petitioner i.e. Court of CJM, Faridabad. It has further been agreed that in case the payment is made the petition shall stand allowed but in case the payment is not made the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed and interim bail consequently rejected.

The petition stands disposed of with abovesaid observations.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
