The grievance of the petitioner is that although, an FIR No.88 dated 30.11.2016 had registered under Sections 307, 382, 323, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran, the police has failed to take any action thereupon and the accused persons are roaming around freely. Despite a detailed representation dated 10.1.2019 (Annexure P2) having been submitted, no action has been taken thereupon, till date.
