In the present writ petition, the prayer is for the release of the pensionary benefits of the petitioner, who has already retired from service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner be given liberty to supplement the earlier legal notice also.

Liberty is granted.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the legal notice dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice

dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.

In case, any supplementary representation is also filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, the same should also be taken into consideration by the respondents while deciding the legal notice.
