Prayer in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reschedule the installments as per RBI guidelines/instructions and further not to take forcible possession over the property i.e. Residential building situated at Ward No.25 Patti Choudhary, Hari Nagar, Gali No.12, Near Ram Nagar and Radha Krishan Public School MCK ID 168C99U85PP measuring 210 Sq. yards and a plot No.39 measuring 502 Sq. yards total land measuring 26K-1M comprised in Khewat No.400 Rect. No.75, Killa No.24/2, 25/1, 25/2 Rect. No.78 Killa No.5/2 Rect. No.79, Killa No.1/1 bearing MCK permanent property Khurana Road DAV Colony, Kaithal Ward No.4, situated at Patti Kaisth Seth Kaithal, within the municipal limit Kaithal.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the bank at the first instance or to take recourse to the alternative remedies as are available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to him, in accordance with law.
