Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner is a resident of Roop Nagar City and in close proximity of Taranjeet Bhasin Bhawan, Roop Nagar.

The assertion made by counsel is that the afore-noticed Bhawan is being used as a marriage palace and in contravention of the terms and conditions of the Notification dated 11.08.2017(Anneure P-2) issued by the Government of Punjab, Department of Housing and Urban Development(Housing II Branch). Counsel urges that the requisite permission has neither been sought nor accorded to the Bhawan and inspite thereof marriage functions are being held on a regular basis much to the nuisance and inconvenience of the local residents. Further contended that loud music at odd hours is being played on a regular basis.

In view of the grievance voiced in the instant petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation to the Deputy

Commissioner, Roop Nagar. In the eventuality of any such representation being filed, respondent No.2 would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
