The petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking the regularization of the services of her late husband Sh. Mahabir in view of the policies dated 01.10.2003 and 10.02.2004. Prior to the present writ petition, late husband of the petitioner had filed CWP No.16021 of 2016, which writ petition was disposed of by this Court by declining to interfere in the matter keeping in view the fact that there is no information and documents supplied by the petitioner Mahabir to substantiate his claim for regularization of his services.

The situation is the same even in the present writ petition. There is no document attached to substantiate the fact that any one who was junior to Sh. Mahabir, have been regularized when Sh. Mahabir was in service.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the redressal of her grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
