The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking writ of *Certiorari*, to quash the order issued for proclamation of sale (Annexure P-4) by respondent No.1.

2. After arguing for some time learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty either to approach the respondent-bank or take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as available to her in accordance with law.
