The grievance raised in the present writ petition is that due to the pendency of FIR No.9 dated 14.10.2009, the petitioner was not promoted as a Field Officer.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the persons junior to the petitioner were promoted. After acquittal, the petitioner became entitled for promotion to the higher post with effect from the date when the persons junior to the petitioner were promoted. Before the said benefit granted to the petitioner, the petitioner superannuated from service on 28.02.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with representations dated 27.04.2018, 28.05.2018 and 08.10.2018 (Annexure P-6 Colly) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representations dated 27.04.2018, 28.05.2018 and 08.10.2018 (Annexure P-6 Colly) by passing appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representations dated 27.04.2018, 28.05.2018 and 08.10.2018 (Annexure P-6 Colly), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations dated 27.04.2018, 28.05.2018 and 08.10.2018 (Annexure P-6 Colly) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
