Prayer in the instant petition, under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Rewal Singh in a cross case bearing DDR No. 31 dated 30.10.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Mour,, District Bathinda arising from FIR No. 216 dated 30.10.2017, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Mour, District Bathinda. The petitioner is facing trial for causing injuries to the complainant party.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused of the petitioner namely Kewal Singh has been named in the FIR. Two Co-accused namely Jarnail Singh and Kewal Singh have been granted anticipatory bail. The petitioner is in custody since 18.12.2018. Conclusion of the trial may take a sufficient long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petitioner is granted interim bail subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
